

Adapter Scheme Q3 2022

Key Dates and Important Information

This document outlines specific information relevant to the Q3 Call for Applications to NCI's Adapter Scheme.

This document should be read in parallel with the **Adapter Scheme Information for Applicants** document.

Background

The Adapter Scheme has been funded for two years by the Australian Government's Department of Education, Skills and Employment under the NCRIS initiative.

This new scheme will facilitate access to data, enable high-throughput compute, and support other new and emerging ways of engaging with Tier-1 high-performance computing and high-performance data resources. The Adapter Scheme is intended to identify meritorious research projects and provide them with flexible access to NCI's Tier-1 HPC system, including cloud services and storage.

Adapter is designed to identify meritorious research projects that need flexible compute access over a short period. This scheme caters for those users who need smaller compute and data resources in short bursts, rather than those who need millions of compute hours over the course of a whole year.

Adapter Scheme allocations in the Q3 call will be up to **250 kSU** per project, valid for a **3-month period from 1 July 2022**.

All fields of research are eligible to apply.





Details for the Q3 Call for Applications

The Q3 Call for Applications will be the first open call of the Adapter Scheme, following a closed, pilot launch in Q1 and Q2 2022. The Q3 Call for Applications is offering HPC resources on the Gadi supercomputer, cloud resources on the Nirin research cloud, and storage resources on NCI's global filesystems.
